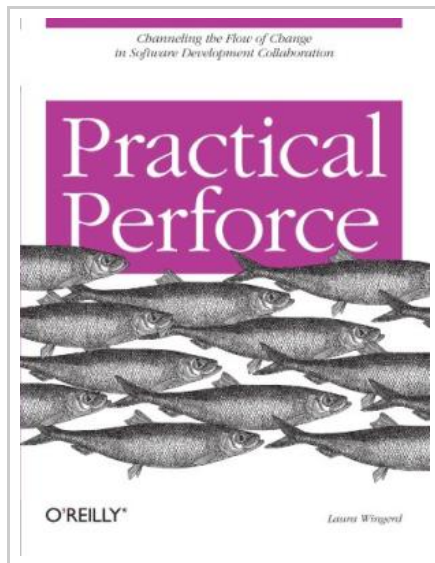




Practical Perforce
