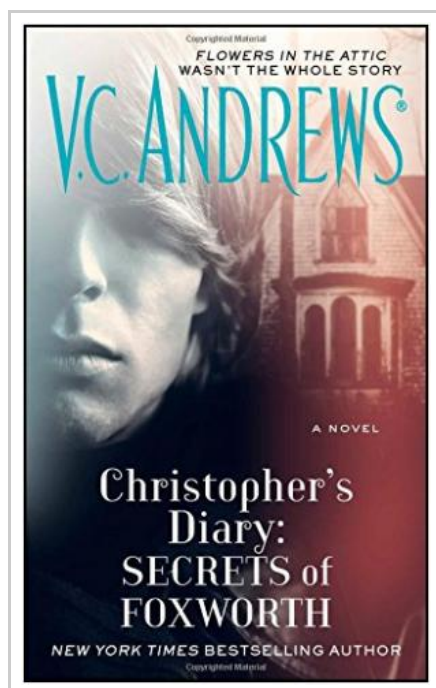




Christopher's Diary: Secrets of Foxworth
